Confronted with unprecedented green, digital and demographic challenges, how can the EU ensure a just transition that leaves no one behind? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>How should common policies be adapted to secure a genuine cohesion in the EU, also taking into account future enlargement? Do we need a new social contract and what should this focus on?</i> • <i>Considering the social disparities associated with previous enlargement rounds, is the social pillar of rights mature enough for new enlargement (in particular, with Ukraine)?</i> • <i>How should the EU manage its budget to repay Next Gen EU, plan for post-2027 expenditures, and address future crises? Should budget flexibility be increased and how?</i> 2. How to better protect the rule of law in the current EU member states? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Are existing tools sufficient and effective (i.e. budget conditionality, cohesion, RRP conditionality, art 7, Commission infringements, annual rule of law reports)?</i> 3. How can the EU function with 30+ members? Which strategic vision for the EU and its neighbourhood? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>How can we enhance regional stability and cooperation while managing potential tensions with neighbours?</i> • <i>Is “absorption capacity” still a relevant concept for the EU?</i> • <i>How to prepare and win voters’ minds for further enlargement? Can the EU survive another shift of gravity?</i> • <i>Can candidate countries be more strongly associated to certain EU policies and their acquis before or as an alternative to joining (e.g. EU-Ukraine Association Agreement)?</i> • <i>Does the EU have enough tools to support candidate countries to prepare for membership?</i> • <i>Enlargement approach: is “fundamentals first” still the right one? Is a focus on absorbing the “acquis communautaire” into national legislation sufficient, or are other tools needed?</i> • <i>How to ensure the functioning of institutions, policies and budget in a Union of 30+ members?</i>
